On behalf of the The Skin Cancer Foundation and upon the recommendation of its Photobiology Committee, I am pleased to affirm that the following product manufactured by Colorescience has been approved for the Seal of Recommendation:

When used regularly in the prescribed manner, this product may also help reduce the potential risk of skin cancer due to overexposure to sunlight". Note that this additional language is optional and provided only as an aid for copy ideas.

The Foundation urges you to display the Seal of Recommendation on your packaging and in your advertising. We believe its visibility on your product will be beneficial. The Foundation receives many calls from the public and the media seeking information on which products have been awarded the Seal. We ask that you provide us with proposed package and advertising copy for advance review so that we can confirm the correct usage of the Seal and language.
